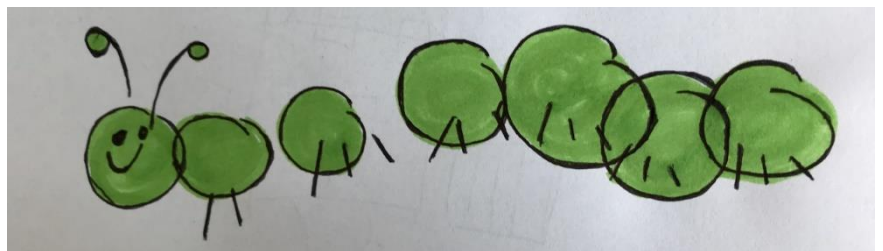


Challenge of the week!
